COVID-19 Safety Procedures

Noggins Corner Farm and the Disaster Animal Response Team of Nova Scotia have always prioritized staff and guest safety and continue to do so as we open our Haunted House for weekends in October 2020.

In accordance with the Public Health Guidance for Nova Scotia and in adherence to the Public Health Order put in place by the province of Nova Scotia, we have updated our health and safety procedures as follows:

Customers will be screened before entry to our Haunted House. Please consider the following before booking your ticket

- ❑ If you feel unwell, please stay home. If you are unwell when you arrive, you will be denied entry to the haunted house.
- ❑ If you have been outside of the Atlantic Bubble in the last 14 days, please stay home as you are required by law to self-isolate for 14 days upon your return.
- ❑ If you have been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19, please ensure you have completed your 14-day isolation period before booking your ticket. (This includes waiting for test results).

What we are doing on site:

- Timed, pre-purchased tickets are available online in order minimize walk ups and long lines to help maintain social distancing practices.
- All guests are required to sanitize their hands prior to entering the haunted house.
- All our staff will be utilizing PPE (face masks and gloves) to protect you and others who come to enjoy the attraction.
- Non-medical masks are MANDATORY for entry to our Haunted House. Face shields or Mingle Masks are not acceptable. We will **not be able** to supply masks to members of the public.
- We are implementing longer time gaps between groups entering the Haunted House to ensure plenty of safe space.
- No combined groups will be allowed. The people you come with are the people you go through the Haunted House with.
- Guests will be spaced out at least 6 feet apart in our queuing line.
- Staff will be screened at the start of each shift; this includes but is not limited to screening for symptoms.
- Extensive cleaning and disinfecting procedures have been put in place throughout the lobby and the attraction itself.
